

Use the word bank below to pick names for these people who can help us to stay safe on the roads.






You can see lots of different vehicles using the road. This is called traffic. Use the word bank to name each vehicle.










How many fire engines can you see below?





Find the safer places to play

Tick the 3 safer places to play then write the correct object for each place. Don't forget to colour all the pictures.


















Three special words before you cross the road

Skooter has 3 special words but they are all mixed up. Can you write each word under the correct picture?




Green Cross Code word search

- 6. **Keep** looking and **listening** for traffic while you cross.




Spotthe difference
